

## **MOBOCES Summer Enrichment Camps 2022**

For Incoming 9th Grade Students (may be opened to other grade levels, based on interest)

- Camp 1 Start Date Monday July 18th
- Camp 2 Start Date Monday August 1st 2-Week Sessions\* - 8:00AM-12:00PM Monday-Thursday
- Cost: \$296 per student (Billed to the district)
- Each camp will be taught by a minimum of two NYS certified BOCES instructors.
- Transportation to camps held at Rossetti will be self- provided by the participating student's family.

Exploring Health Related Careers – Students will have the opportunity to become First Aid and CPR Certified in this camp. They will also learn select basic nursing skills utilizing the current CNA Health Related Careers CTE curriculum. Students will engage in hands on health care experiences in our on-campus hospital lab including learning how change a sterile dressing, anatomy lessons, infection control practices, and career cruising to research and explore different avenues of healthcare. They will also have the opportunity to participate in other fun healthcare experiments such as sunscreen effectiveness and sun damage. Limited to 20 students per session.

Life Skills Camp – In this experience, students will cover a wide variety of topics that will only enhance their ability to care for themselves and others as they grow older. Students will learn basic cooking and meal prep/planning techniques. They will also engage in hands on lessons and instruction that will help them better navigate finances and money management, as well as basic sewing and independent living skills. Students will experience fieldtrips to local essential places of business to learn how to better navigate their local communities (The Post Office, banks, grocery stores).

\*One session only; 2-weeks, 12-15 students.

Introduction to Agriculture – Students will study basic agricultural concepts including animal care, conservation practices, farming, gardening and landscaping. Utilizing the longstanding MOBOCES partnership with Clinton Tractor, students will also be exposed to various tools and equipment necessary in the agriculture field and setting. Students will engage in fieldtrips and other various community connections during this camp. Excursions will include, but are not limited to: The Boonville Fair, dairy farming experiences and basic skills introduction, and local farm tours. 12-15 students per session.

#### **MOSART – Project Fibonacci STEAM Camps**

**MOBOCES** is partnering with **MOSART** and **ANDRO Computational Solutions** to offer summer minicamps that are focused on STEAM and the diversity and complexity of solutions. These camps can be scheduled and offered in district for flexibility.

Each camp is project-based and focused on the ideas of entrepreneurship, collaboration, and problem solving skills. Mini drone camps help students work collectively with technology to simulate different ideas such as space travel to Mars or Sustainability in Climate Change. Students will use robotics to focus on the essential communication between people and technology. The utilization of a variety of *AI* tools helps students to learn key ideals for machines and datasets. Students will work together in a co-curricular model enriched with hands-on learning opportunities to help disseminate machine learning and communication with technology.

\*May be offered as a 2 or 4 day camps, with a possibility for full week sessions. Guest speakers are available to discuss current work force situations with students as well.
